

Care & Cleaning Instructions

Palmer leg systems are made of solid brass, and are offered in chrome and nickel plated finishes, as well as UNlacquered polished brass and UNlacquered oil-rubbed bronze.

- The **polished chrome (PC)** finish will not tarnish, and will generally need no care other than normal cleaning and dusting with a damp soft cloth.
- The **polished nickel (PN)** and **satin nickel (SN)** finishes are durable, but will eventually slightly dull and tarnish, and show some fingerprints and watermarks. These finishes should be cleaned with a mild metal polish such as Flitz or Never Dull brands. Do not use a liquid metal polish, as it will tend to collect in the crevices and turn green. To preserve the restored finish, we recommend applying a wax protectant such as Flitz Faucet WaxPlus or a fine furniture wax such as Butcher's worked into a soft, clean cloth and buffed onto the metal.
- The **polished brass (PBUL)** finish is UNlacquered and designed to naturally tarnish to an authentic aged patina. If you would prefer to preserve the shiny look, just follow the same instructions as for nickel, but apply more frequently - about once a month, depending on use.
- Our **oil-rubbed bronze (ORB)** finish requires nothing more than an occasional dusting. It is a living finish and should NEVER be polished.



The Palmer **Acrylic Rod (ACR)** can be cleaned and polished in the field with Novus 1 Plastic Clean & Shine. The Plastic Clean & Shine will gently clean all plastics without scratching, and leave a lustrous finish that resists fogging and finger marking, repels dust, and eliminates static. Novus Scratch Removers 2 & 3 will remove fine scratches, haziness, and abrasions while sealing the Acrylic with a fine coat of polish. A bit of time and "elbow grease" will be required to remove scratches, so patience is a prerequisite....but, unlike glass, Acrylic can be field repaired.

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
